Shall the Town raise and appropriate the sum of Six Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$685,000) for the purpose of replacement of Bridge No. 108/070 on Taylor Road, Five Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$548,000) of such sum to be reimbursed from the State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation, and One Hundred Thirty-Seven Thousand Dollars (\$137,000) of such sum to be raised by taxation? This will be non-lapsing appropriation for as long as the money remains available under the rules or practice of the State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation, or when the project is completed, whichever comes sooner, in accordance with RSA 32:7 IV. In addition, the taxpayer must have a net income of not more than \$27,000, or, if married, a combined net income of less than \$37,000 and own net assets not in excess of \$61,000 excluding the value of the person's residence.
