DRAFTMINUTES PLANNING BOARD MEETING January 2, 2019

The Board reviewed the minutes of the January 2, 2019 meeting. Bert accepted the minutes as written.

Public Hearings:

Bert read the Public Notice to open the Public Hearings.

Public Hearing-Excavation Regulations:

Lou made a motion to approve the updated Excavation Regulations. Deirdre seconded the motion. The Board voted 6-0 to approve the new Excavation Regulations.

Public Hearing-Zoning Amendment:

Deirdre made a motion to place the Amendment on the Warrant Article. Lou seconded the motion. The Board voted 6-0 to approve the Amendment.

Public Hearing-Subdivision Regulations-Homeowner's Association:

Ned made a motion to approve the updated Homeowner's Association portion of the Subdivision Regulations. Deirdre seconded the motion. The motion passed with a 6-0 vote.

River Road Bridge:

Bert stated that he received an email from Ms. Darrow requesting specific regulations and applications which he sent to her. The Board will wait for her response.

Nate Sikkila:

Mr. Sikkila addressed the Board requesting an extension of his Intent to Excavate in conjunction with a building permit. Mr. Sikkila explained that extenuating circumstances have delayed the progress on the excavation. Deirdre made a motion to extend the application to November 1, 2020. The date was amended by the Board to January 1, 2021. The Board voted 5-1 to extend the application to January 1, 2021 with a condition as follows: If the excavation portion is not completed by that time, Mr. Sikkila will need to come before the Board and be subject to the new Excavation Regulations.
