Eversource has contracted with Doucet Survey Inc. to conduct survey work in various locations in Amherst, Brookline, Fitzwilliam, Greenville, Mason, Milford, New Ipswich and Rindge to support the final phase of the System Resiliency Program work that took place late last year.

Last summer, Eversource issued notifications to abutters along this power line corridor notifying them of our upcoming System Resiliency Program and the start of pre-construction activities. Our Engineering team had identified upgrades along the line to strengthen the infrastructure and reduce the possibility of service interruptions, especially during severe weather. As the final phase to that project, the survey crew will be in the power line corridor this month. The purpose for the survey work being conducted post construction is to ensure the accuracy of the construction contractors work by verifying its adherence to the design specifications outlined by our engineers.

Eversource has authorized Doucet Survey Inc., who may be visible to you in and/or around the Eversource right-of-way, to survey this corridor. Please note that this work is not related to the Kinder Morgan Pipeline Project.
