

BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING
AUGUST 25, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m.

Selectman Doyle informed the Board the MS-5 has been completed and will be sent to the DRA. Joanne added that the Board of Assessors had been granted an extension on filing of the MS-1 to September 15 (due September 1).

Selectman Doyle made a motion to enter into a non public session under RSA 91-A:3II(b), the hiring of any person as a public employee. Selectman Meiszner seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

At 11:45 p.m. Selectman Doyle made a motion to return to public session. Selectman Meiszner seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Selectman Lawrence gave an update on the house at 1473 Turnpike Road. The clean-up is being put out to bid by the real estate company. The State Health Department contacted Selectman Lawrence because of a complaint they had received. Water testing by Spindleback Lane homeowners and Mrs. Straitiff have come back negative for contamination. Two people were seen unloading rubbish in the back of the home a few days ago.
