

BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING
MAY 27, 2014

PRESENT: George Lawrence, Chairman, Becky Doyle, Joanne Meshna

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. at the Town Office.

Selectman Doyle made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 20, 2014 meeting. Selectman Lawrence seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Greg and Karen Cain - The Cains have applied for a fireworks permit and release from the noise ordinance for July 3, 2014 from 6:00 p.m. to midnight. The permit will be forwarded to the Fire Chief and Police Chief for their approval. Fees of \$25.00 are included with the application.

AYSO - The Board reviewed the AYSO contract with the carnival and initialed they had done so. Selectmen Lawrence made a motion to accept the contract with East Coast Midways, LLC to put on a carnival at the New Ipswich memorial field beginning on June 5 and ending on June 8, 2014. Selectman Doyle seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Mrs. Buxton later joined the meeting. She has attempted to contact the Fire Chief regarding inspections but without success. Selectman Doyle will call the Fire Chief. Mrs. Buxton spoke with the Police Chief and Peter Goewey.

Fire Department Explorer - Paperwork was submitted to add a new Explorer to the Fire Department. Selectman Lawrence made a motion to approve the new Explorer as a member of the New Ipswich Fire Department. Becky seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Turnpike Auto Parts - A renewal for a junkyard permit was submitted for Turnpike Auto Parts. The Board agreed to a site visit on June 10, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. Joanne will notify Mr. Pelletier.

Peter Lawler and Amanda Carvill - An application for release from the noise ordinance was filed by Mr. Lawler and Ms. Carvill for August 9 from 8:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. for a wedding reception at 84 Ashburnham Road. The Police Chief needs to be notified. The application was held for next week's meeting.

Stearns Burton - Requests from Stearns Burton for payment from the trust were approved for the Keene American Legion band and Eyes on Owls in the amount of \$500.00 each.

Monadnock Conservancy - Emily Hague from Monadnock Conservancy will conduct an inspection of a violation of the easement agreement at the Nussdorfer Nature Area on June 4, 2010 at 1:30 p.m.

NH Selectperson Institute - Selectman Doyle will call and register herself and Woody for the training to be held on June 7, 2014 at 8:30 a.m. in Concord.

Souhegan Valley Ambulance Agreement - Selectman Doyle made a motion that Selectman Lawrence sign the ambulance service agreement. George seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Pool - The work at the pool should be finished at the end of the week. Selectmen Doyle had questions regarding applications for employment and she will contact Liz.

At 6:45 p.m. Selectman Doyle made a motion to enter into non public session under RSA 91-A:3 II.c. Selectman Lawrence seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

At 7:30 p.m. the public meeting reconvened. Selectman Lawrence announced that the minutes were sealed and no decisions were made that can be publicly announced.

New Ipswich Fire Brigade - Mr. David Cotzin informed the Board that he had spoken with Rick Gravell who was still interested in the Fire Brigade organization. He also spoke with the Keurulainens and Alan Soini. The roof of the building is leaking and the Fire Brigade will fix it. Selectman Doyle noted that there is a town bank account in the amount of \$10.26 that has to be closed. Mr. Cotzin will contact Jim Coffey.

Mr. Cotzin reminded the Board that there is a hearse being stored at the Barrett Mansion that belongs to the Town. Selectman Doyle noted that it needs to be on the Town's inventory list.

Selectman Lawrence made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:45 p.m. Selectman Doyle seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
