

BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING
SEPTEMBER 10, 2014
9:00 AM

PRESENT: George Lawrence, Chairman, Becky Doyle, Woody Meiszner

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. at the Town Office.

Ford Taurus bids: Selectman Lawrence reviewed the conditions of the bid: minimum bid is \$3,500, deposit of \$500 bank check due by September 11 and the balance is due prior to pick-up by September 23, 2014. Two bids were received. Timothy and/or Rachel Muhonen, 27 Green Farm Road, submitted a bid of \$4,300. Peter Goewey, 10 Highlandview Road, Claremont, submitted a bid of \$5,500. Selectman Doyle made a motion to accept the bid from Peter Goewey for the 2008 Ford Taurus as long as the terms in the ad are met. Selectman Lawrence seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Selectman Doyle made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 2, 2014 10:00 a.m. minutes. Selectman Lawrence seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Selectman Doyle made a motion to approve the non public session minutes of the September 2, 2014 10:05 meeting. Selectman Lawrence seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Selectman Lawrence made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 2, 2014 6:00 p.m. minutes. Selectman Meiszner seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

The minutes of the September 2, 2014 6:35 p.m. non public session were amended to correct the spelling of Meiszner in paragraph two. Selectman Doyle made a motion to approve the minutes as amended. Selectman Lawrence seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Preliminary grant meeting: Woody announced that he would be meeting today at 10:00 a.m. with J. B. Mack from Southwest Region Planning Commission, Peter Goewey, Chief Carpenter and Gary Somero to discuss submission of a grant for sidewalks along Temple, Turnpike and King Roads.

Chief Carpenter: Chief Carpenter announced they had lost communications last night at 11:00 p.m.

David Cotzin: Mr. Cotzin informed the Board that after telling Senator Gilmour about the dangerous intersection at Nashua Road and Route 123, he received a call a few days later from the NH DOT and they are following up on it. Mr. Cotzin also asked when paving of roads is to begin and it will start October 1 depending on the weather.

Highway Department: Selectman Meiszner announced that he had received an e-mail complimenting the Highway Department on their work on Mason Road after the storm on Saturday.

Treasurer: Bev presented signature cards for four accounts for the Selectmen to sign.
