BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING
JUNE 5, 2018

<u>Budget:</u> The Board reviewed the current budget. The line item for salt in the Department of Public Works budget is in the negative. It was agreed to remove \$14,800 from the salt line item budget and reallocate it to the Highway Block Grant.

<u>Parks and Recreation:</u> Selectman Hopkins noted he had attended the chicken barbeque at the recreation field on Saturday. He was impressed by all the activity at the field and congratulated the Recreation Department for a job well done.
