It was discussed that Kim Rhodes could be of assistance since he knows more about trees and is already contracted to do brush work in the cemeteries. As this discussion was being held, Kim walked up with his dog as they were out for their evening stroll.

Kim says he will assess the trees in this cemetery and maybe others for tree removal. Further discussion will be held after Kim makes these assessments. If the snow comes before that, it will wait until Spring and the "bad trees" will be watched while there is snow on the ground. Currently they aren't endangering too many monuments so they might be alright until the Spring.
