

CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING  
JANUARY 2, 2007

Members met at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Office to discuss 2007 warrant articles.

The first article establishes a portion of Timbertop Road as a scenic road and reads as follows: "To see if the Town will vote to designate Timbertop Road, from the intersection of Huse and Willard Farm Roads to the Rindge town line, as a Scenic Road in accordance with RSA 231:157."

The second article establishes a land conservation capital reserve fund and reads as follows: "To see if the Town will vote to establish a Land Conservation Capital Reserve Fund as permitted by RSA 35:1, III-a for the purpose of acquiring land or interests in land, to be managed and controlled by the conservation commission, and to name the Selectmen as agents to expend the fund as authorized under RSA 41:14-a."

The third article authorizes the Selectmen to acquire or sell land and/or buildings and reads as follows: "To see if the Town will vote to adopt the provisions of RSA 41:14-a, relating to Acquisition or Sale of Land, Buildings, or Both."

The last article appropriates money to the land conservation capital reserve fund and reads as follows: "To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$50,000 from the Fund Balance to the Land Conservation Capital Reserve Fund."

Doug made a motion to submit all four warrant articles as written. Freddi seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
