12-April 2023 Conservation Commission Meeting Minutes

Bob Boynton called the meeting to order at 19:30.

The ConCom reviewed the minutes for the 08-February 2023 and 08-March 2023 meetings. Matt Olivera made a motion to approve the minutes with editorial corrections. Kleta Dudley seconded the motion, and all members were in favor.

Bob Boynton stated that a Blue-Green Algae bloom [Cyanobacteria] has been reported at the Taylor Road Pond. Cyanobacteria is a hazard to humans, pets and wildlife if consumed and when swimming. Bob will call the NH Department of Environmental Services [DES] to request guidance regarding what action needs to be taken for public warning posting and remediation.

Bob Boynton stated that the ConCom currently has a \$60k commitment to the Piscataquoga Land Conservancy. The members discussed several strategies to research other properties for land conservation using the available escrow account funds with a balance of approximately \$210k including land purchases and easements. The members discussed partnering with other conservation organizations [e.g., Monadnock Conservancy, Ashburnham Conservation Trust, Northeast Wilderness Trust] active in the area. In addition, the members will also reach out to several local landowners for conservation opportunities.

Bob Boynton adjoined the meeting.
