CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING JUNE 8, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. at the Town Office.

David made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 12, 2010 meeting. Dixie seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Committee Reports:

Open Space: Bob will be meeting with Dennis McKenney regarding the survey for the Rice lot off Flinkstrom Road, lot 3/4, tomorrow at 3:00 p.m. The survey has proven to be more difficult than first thought and therefore the cost may be more than estimated.

Trails: Jack spoke with Tom Brumaghim regarding clean up on the Nussdorfer Trail. They will walk the trail sometime next week.

The trail on the Kellogg property was discussed. Jack and Doug will walk it again and locate it on a topo map. Bob suggested they also flag it.

Water Resources: Members were given the latest proposal for the golf course. Bob asked Joanne to see if there is a map with GPS coordinates on it so that the location of the ponds can be determined. Questions arose as to where the sources of water would come from to fill the ponds and if the collection of water in the ponds would impact other areas.

<u>New Business:</u> Bob suggested that a wetlands inventory be done of local wetlands. An overlay map could then be created that could be used to pinpoint wetlands during building or subdividing to determine impact to the wetlands. The inventory should be done by a professional wetlands scientist. Bob added that this was a long term important project and asked members to think about it.

Saari Excavating submitted their final bill for work on the Johnson property. It included \$600.00 for gravel for the driveway that had not been in the original estimate. Jack made a motion to approve payment of the \$600.00. Dixie seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
