Kona ice will do as a fundraiser at the event, possibly have the cheerleaders of Boynton/ Mascenic help with that so they can earn that money. The obstacle course that has been discussed is still not guaranteed. Insurance will not cover it so people would have to sign a waiver to use it. I will follow up with the selectmen.

- Movie night- possibly see if families or companies want to sponsor movie nights. Maybe \$50 and it comes with four free popcorns, candy and drinks and they get to pick an approved movie to show at the field(thoughts were positive)

- Easter Egg Hunt- total cost of event was \$223.56 we will be holding the event next year before Easter and I'd like to find new games. We saved all the eggs so we will just need to purchase candy again next year.

-Soccer- Jen discussed some fundraiser ideas- stickers of our logo sell for \$1 cost for 1,000/ \$190 this money will go towards the program. Also she has almost a full board!!
